

EMERGENCY SERVICES EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

Alberta Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. (AVFD) is accepting applications for several part-time Virginia or National Registry Certified Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) at the Basic, Intermediate, and Paramedic levels. BLS providers shall have current EMT-Basic, EVOC, & CPR certification. ALS providers shall have current EMT- I or P, EVOC, CPR, PALS, & ACLS certifications. Applicants who are cross-trained with fire service certifications are desired but not required for employment.

All applicants shall be a minimum 21 years of age, hold a current Virginia driver's license, have a high school diploma or equivalent, and pass a medical examination to evaluate physical condition. Applicants shall also pass an EMS test station pertaining to their current level of training.

Rotating shift schedules will be used to cover 12 hour periods from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. with possible overtime. Job duties include, but not limited to, providing patient care, completing necessary paperwork, performing administrative functions, performing basic vehicle and facility maintenance.

These part-time positions do not contain benefits and the pay range for all BLS and ALS positions shall be commensurate with experience and certification levels. Deadline for applications will be Wednesday, November 21, 2007. A current criminal history background check and DMV license record is required of all applicants. Final employment decisions are contingent on approval by the agency's Operational Medical Director (OMD).
